Book collectors are interesting people. It takes years if not decades of dedicated pursuit to amass a fine collection of books focused on a particular subject. We find new homes for existing subject-specific book collections.

Collecting books in any serious way involves a huge amount of effort, time and money. (See our Personal Bookselling page for more details on how to collect books through Heywood Hill.) Motivations vary but collectors are often driven by a devotion to a subject bordering on love and sometimes approaching obsession. Many would like their efforts to be taken on by another or cannot bear to see their shelves broken up at auction. This is where we come in.

We advise collectors or their heirs on what to do with a good book collection in need of new life or a new home. Owners consign worldclass collections to us. We broker the sale of collections of books between private sellers and our worldwide network of private or institutional buyers.

Here are details of four formed collections currently for sale.

Helmut Friedlaender's Baedeker Collection

Helmut Friedlaender (1913-2008) was a sophisticated and eclectic bibliophile, whose passions included literature, science and law and Hebraica. He served on the Council of Fellows of the Morgan Library and was awarded the Bodleian Medal from the Bodleian Library of the University of Oxford.

Despite selling his collection at Christie's in 2001, he continued to indulge in his passion for books, particularly for Baedeker travel guides of which he amassed a large collection, including many of the rarest editions. Karl Baedeker was a German publisher who produced informative guidebooks in German, French and English that set a standard for tourism across Europe and the Middle East. Close to 1,000 Baedeker volumes in their handsome tan or red cloth bindings are offered here.

The Phil Martin Association Football Collection

Over many decades Phil Martin has created the finest private collection of books and other material on football in the world. This comprises well over 5,000 printed books and related material covering the overall history of the game, club histories, biographies of players, managers and administrators, Boy's Annuals, reference books and football in fiction and poetry; around 600 brochures and booklets; 1,500 directories and handbooks; photographs, magazines and cards; antique prints and sound recordings.
